



COVID-19: Update on Safety Measures in City of Winnipeg Facilities

In accordance with [provincial public health orders](#) published on September 2, 2021, proof of immunization is now required to visit and participate in indoor programming at City-operated [pools](#), [fitness](#) and [leisure centres](#), and [arenas](#) beginning September 3, 2021.

Proof of immunization is not required to visit a [library](#) branch; however, select indoor programming will require proof of immunization – participants will be notified accordingly.

Individuals that do not show proof of immunization as required will not be permitted to enter the facility or participate in programming, unless they fall under an exemption in the provincial public health orders.

Customers are encouraged to bring a piece of government-issued ID to confirm that their identity matches their COVID-19 immunization card.

Face masks are also required to be worn in City facilities, except when swimming or while engaged in other athletic activities. Residents are encouraged to review the [self-assessment symptom checklist](#). Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms will be asked not to enter our facilities.
